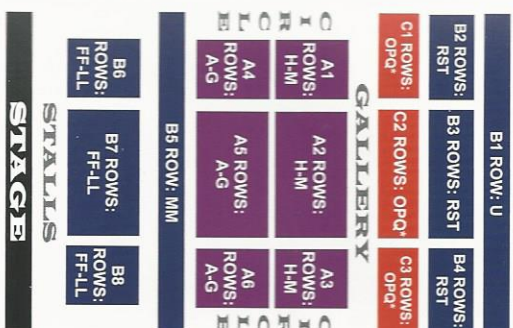

 105th season when
 we'll be playing some
 of the greatest works
 from the classical
 orchestral repertoire.

Remarkably, four of our soloists are still in their teens. We've the current BBC Young Musician, pianist Martin James Bartlett, a welcome return for his immediate predecessor, the wonderful cellist Laura van der Heijden, a superb pianist from South Korea, Taek-Ci Lee, and a brilliant violinist, Callum Smart, who hails from Tunbridge Wells. There's also master trumpeter Paul Beniston, principal of the London Philharmonic, who was born in Chatham and still lives locally. They're performing exciting concertos by Rachmaninov, Walton, Mozart, Prokofiev and the Armenian composer Arutunian.

The best-known Armenian composer is Khachaturian, and we start the season with three pieces from his ballet "Gayane", including the famous "Sabre Dance". We're also featuring spectacular orchestral works by Rimsky-Korsakov, Richard Strauss, Roussel, Elgar, Nielsen, Dvorak, Mahler, Borodin and Tchaikovsky, plus the haunting "Adagio for strings" by Samuel Barber. So there's something on offer for every musical taste. Spread the word and enjoy...!

The Orchestra:

Maidstone Symphony Orchestra is one of the UK's finest "community" orchestras. It was formed in 1910 as Maidstone Orchestral Society, still the title of the concert promoting organisation. Today MSO is a superbly well-balanced mix of local professionals and ex-professionals, music teachers and excellent amateur players who come together regularly on a voluntary basis to produce concerts of a professional standard. This entails great commitment by the players, many of whom travel from all over Kent, and beyond, to attend MSO's weekly Thursday evening rehearsals.

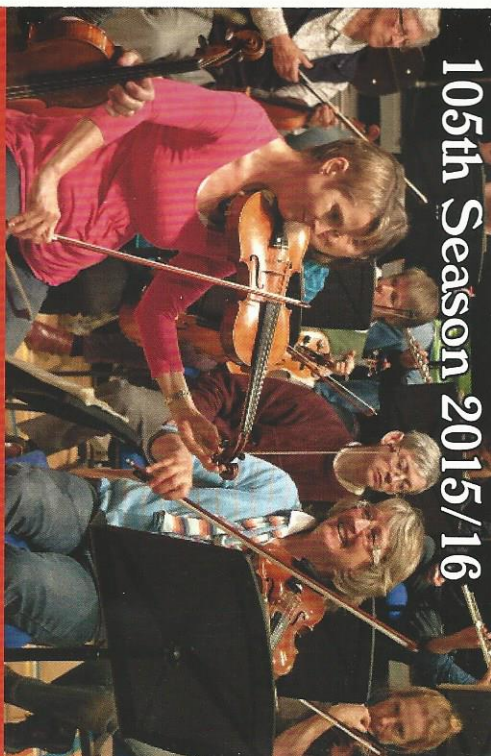
